

PARK HILLS CIVIC ASSOCIATION

Minutes

1. The meeting held on November 10, 1948, was opened by the President at 8:30 P.M.

2. The minutes of the October 13 meeting were read.

3. The Treasurer's report was not available at this meeting.

4. A report was given by Mr. Baines regarding the island hazard located in the 100 block of Dale Drive.

It was resolved unanimously that: The island located in the center of Dale Drive, about the 100 block, should be eliminated.

5. The Secretary was requested by the President to write a letter notifying the proper authorities as to the substance of this resolution.

6. The subject of traffic lights at Dale and Colesville Road, Sligo Pkwy. and Piney Branch Road, and Sligo Pkwy. and Colesville Road was brought up again. The President requested the Secretary to write a letter to the Traffic Committee of the Allied Civic Group suggesting lights be erected at the mentioned intersections.

7. Mr. Ralph Boyd informed the President and the members at this meeting that the Allied Civic Group went on record for an elected School Board. Mr. Boyd offered a Resolution: That the method used now in acquiring a School Board be changed to appointment of the Board by the ~~City~~ ^{COUNTY} Council. Mr. L. Everett suggested study of this resolution and made a motion to table the resolution until some future date when it would be discussed more thoroughly; Mr. Everett seconded this motion.

8. The President asked Mr. Ralph Boyd to explain the Silver Spring Hospital Association plans. It was resolved by the group, present at this meeting, that before any resolutions were suggested that some thought be given to the Hospital problem. Mr. Boyd suggested to the President a possibility of getting a speaker for our next meeting.

9. The subject of the charter was brought up. The President recommended that the delegates to the Allied Civic Group from the Park Hills Civic Assoc. make a motion at the next meeting of the Allied Civic Group that a joint meeting of all associations be called and have speakers on hand to explain the charter.

10. Mr. Boyd requested that he be released as a delegate to the Allied Civic Group from the Park Hills Civic Assoc. Mr. Boyd informed this group that he has a lifetime membership in the Civic Group. The President stated he would consider the request.
